The FUTURE IN PRIMARY CARE is challenging – with increasingly knowledgeable and demanding patients, escalating litigation rates, the potential changes in the medicosocio-economic structure etc.

The Scientific Committee has identified several very important subjects for the primary care physicians e.g. the increasing prevalence of DM and ageing of our population which will shift the burden of DM care and neuropsychiatric care of the elderly to the primary care physician. Dementia, once thought to be a Westerner's disease, is becoming common in ASEAN. Prevalence of atrial fibrillation is certain to rise, and you will have to anticoagulate and monitor many of them.

We will also explore several niches that can potentially be incorporated into your practice, i.e. Aesthetic Medicine, Traditional and Complementary Medicine and Health Screening.
